

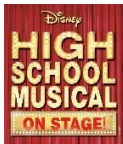


2020 VATE Writing Competition – Creative Writing


