



# **Primary Sports & Houses**

### What:

Every student who attends Marymede Catholic College is a member of a House. There are six College Houses and each has a patron and colour. They are Chanel, Chisholm, Marcellin, McAuley, McCormack and Romero. On House sports and activity days, students wear their coloured House uniform and on event days, will compete for House points.

Students participate in weekly House sport competitions with students from their Year level. They play traditional and modified games. In addition to the weekly House sport, students compete in major House Carnivals throughout the year, including the Walkathon, Cross Country, Athletics and Swimming.

Students also participate in Drama, Talent Quest and Art Activities in their Houses.

## **Interschool Sports:**

Marymede Catholic College is part of the Bridge Inn District sporting competition. We compete in Swimming, Cross Country, Athletics, T-Ball, Soccer, AFL, Volleyball, Cricket, Netball against 8 other Schools in our area.

Students who are successful in Bridge Inn District competitions have the opportunity to progress to Whittlesea/Woodlands Division, the Northern Metropolitan Region and finally the State Level Competitions.
