



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM

Marymede Catholic College has a vibrant music department with a strong team of professional musicians as well as dedicated and experienced teachers. Together with excellent facilities, Marymede is well equipped to provide every student with outstanding opportunities to develop their musical talents.

LESSONS:

- Year 1-Year 6 Private/Shared Lesson 30 minutes
- Year 7-10 Private/Shared Lesson 30 minutes Private Lesson and 45-minute Shared Lesson
- Year 11-12 Private Lesson 45 minutes

Students in Year 1 to Year 6 who have private music lessons are escorted to and from their music lesson by their instrumental teacher.

Students in Year 7-12 are expected to know their timetable and attend their lessons independently. Their music lesson will appear on their classroom roll as a 'School Related Absence- Music Lesson'.

Lessons will rotate weekly so that there are minimal disruptions to the student's scheduled class time.

PARTICIPATION:

For all students to obtain the maximum benefit from Music at Marymede Catholic College, students are expected to:

- Demonstrate a continuing commitment to regular practice.
- Participate in at least one music co-curricular activity to gain valuable experience in group Rehearsal.
- Perform at school-based events such as Masses, Liturgies, assemblies, concerts and ceremonies.

INSTRUMENTS:

The college currently offers private instrumental music lessons for: Voice, Piano, Violin, Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Drum Kit, Percussion, Guitar and Bass Guitar.







TERMS AND CONDITIONS FORM 2023

- § All students enrolled in the College's Instrumental Music Program are committed to a **FULL SEMESTER** of lessons.
- § ALL STUDENTS ARE AUTOMATICALLY ENROLLED INTO THE FOLLOWING SEMESTER.
- § If a student wishes to discontinue lessons, then written notice e-mailed to ellen.lane@marymede.vic.edu.au or declining the PAM enrolment form must be sent before the end of the current semester. Failure to meet this deadline will result in a full semester's fee being payable.
- § Fees are invoiced by the College on a semester basis. Fees are paybale within 14 days of receiving the invoice.
- § The College will **NOT** provide refunds to families who decide to discontinue instrumental lessons before the end of semester.
- § If written notice of cancellation is not presented, the College will presume students will continue learning for a **FULL YEAR** under the same agreement as outlined here.
- § The student will receive *16 lessons* per semester.

16 x Year 1-Year 6 Lesson = \$650.00 (30 minutes Private) per student / \$450.00 (30 minutes - Shared) per student

16 x Year 7-10 Lesson = \$650.00 (30 minutes - Private) per student / \$650.00 (45 minutes - Shared) per student

16 x Year 11-12 Lesson = \$950.00 (45 minutes - Private) per student

12 x Year 12 Lesson, Semester 2 Only = \$725.00 (45 minutes - Private) per student

- **Please note if there are not enough students to make up pairs for shared lessons, students may be in a shared lesson on their own with a slightly reduced lesson time. **
- Yr. 1-6 Shared Lesson on own = 20-25min.
- Yr. 7-10 Shared Lesson on own 35-40 mins.

Students will technically get an individual lesson one on one with the teacher with a slightly reduced time at the 'Shared' price.

Instrument Maintenance Fee= \$100 (This is a once-off fee for the year and still applies to students who join in Sem 2 or at any other point through the year). This fee is applicable to all students who use the Marymede Catholic College instruments. This includes all students learning Piano and Drums.





§ If the Instrumental teacher is absent for a scheduled lesson then the lesson will be rescheduled, way of Mary—and students will be notified of the time and date of the rescheduled lesson.

§ Music timetables are scheduled around college events/activities however sometimes not all events/activities are made known to teachers. If a student is going to be absent from school due to a **COLLEGE APPROVED ACTIVITY**, we ask the student to still inform the Instrumental Music teacher. When possible, the Instrumental Music teacher will endeavour to reschedule the lesson at another time **providing 48 hours notice** is given to the Instrumental Music teacher.

§ If a student is going to be unable to attend a scheduled lesson due to an **Examination, SAC**, test, assignment or sporting activity, it is the responsibility of the student to inform the Instrumental Music teacher. The Instrumental Music teacher will endeavour to reschedule the lesson at another **time providing 48 hours notice** is given to the Instrumental Music teacher.

§ If a student is absent due to illness or holiday on the day of a lesson, the lesson will still be payable. We ask that a courtesy email be sent to the Instrumental teacher notifying them of student absence due to illness or holiday. Students may ask for a make-up lesson, but it will be at the discretion of the Instrumental teacher. They do not need to provide a make-up.

§ Students participating in the College's Instrumental Music Program are expected to support the musical life of the College by participating in extra-curricular bands, choirs and/or college performances when required.

§ Instrumental Music teachers will communicate predominately via email so please make sure you and your child are checking your emails daily for updates or new schedules.

NB: Please note Instrumental Music enrolments are subject to the availability of our instrumental staff. Parents/ Guardians acceptance does not guarantee a place into the music instrumental program.
